FINE ARTS FESTIVAL RULES

CONDUCT

1. **Participants** - Fine Arts participants must attend orientation. It is very important that each participant be present at the time his or her number is called. Those who are late will be skipped. They will not be allowed to minister in a later time slot. (There will be slight allowances made for those who are competing in multiple events.) Remember to treat others as you would like to be treated when you are sharing your ministry. Please keep noise and movement to a minimum.
2. **Spectators** - It is also important that spectators keep noise and movement to a minimum. For many of our youth, this is a first time experience. They do not need distractions. Do not leave or enter the rooms while they are sharing their talent.

COMPETITION

The official rules provided by the Assemblies of God Youth Department will be used for the Fine Arts competition. Three to five qualified judges have been selected for each category of the Fine Arts Festival. The high and low scores are thrown out. The middle three scores are then used to evaluate the participants' ministry. All judging will be done on the official judging score sheets. Score sheets will be sent to each participant at a later date. The Awards Ceremony will be at approximately 4 PM today in the sanctuary.
